Barge which rammed into boats held

KLANG: The Marine Department has detained a barge which rammed into several boats, including the Sultan of Selangor's yacht, at the Royal Selangor Yacht Club on Thursday night.

A department official said the barge, laden with iron material, was scheduled to leave the port for Singapore yesterday but its departure had to be put off following the accident in which the Sultan's yacht Pateri Kayangan, was scratched and two bouts sank. The barge also damaged


soveral other boats and demolished the club's pontoon.
